HOW WE FEEL ON THE INSIDE AND HOW WE ACT ON THE OUTSIDE



Sometimes things happen in our lives that make us feel sad, afraid, or angry. No matter how we feel, we can't let our feelings make us do things that are wrong, like hurting someone else.

We can learn a lot about that from a man named Joseph, who lived a very long time ago. You can read about him in Genesis 37-50 in your Trailbook or Bible.

Joseph loved God and wanted to follow Him, but it seemed like bad things were always happening to him! His brothers were jealous of him, so they sold him as a slave and he was taken to Egypt. While he was there, he got thrown in prison for something he didn't even do.

He probably felt sad, lonely, and afraid. But he kept doing what he knew was right and never treated anyone else badly. He had joy in his heart because he knew God was with him, and he trusted God's plan for him and everything he was going through.



Then Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, had two strange dreams. God told Joseph the dreams meant that in a few years, no crops would grow and people would run out of food. When Joseph told Pharaoh, Pharaoh put him in charge of saving up food before that happened, so the people would have enough to eat. When Joseph's family ran out of food, his brothers came to Egypt to get more. Joseph realized God had sent him to Egypt to save his family when they couldn't grow food!
